In the matter of **t/a Beclaws**, the Commissioners reviewed an email dated June 19, 2018 regarding a request to extend the hours of operation until 3:00 a.m. The chairman indicated additional information would be required for the Board to act on this request.

In the matter of **t/a Crescent Wine & Beer**, the Commissioners reviewed a letter dated June 8, 2018 regarding a change in the hours of operation to 9:00 a.m. to Midnight Monday through Sunday. Mr. Camacho moved to approve this change, seconded by Ms. Kelsey, and made unanimous by Mr. Graham.
